- Cross-hatching indicates the zone in which each company (by color) may place station markers and may upgrade tiles. (Cross-hatched square)

- Himalaya (Large orange triangle)
- Single River (Blue line)
- Multiple Rivers (Blue branching line)

In each hex that has at least one of these terrain features, the cost to lay the first (yellow) tile in that hex is shown as two values, "£a/£b", where the first number is for a standard-gauge track tile and the second, lower cost is for a metre-gauge track tile. (Exception: In Calcutta, only one value is shown because the first tile laid there must be tile 104, which is brown and has dual-gauge track.)

Upgrading an existing tile in any hex is always free of charge.
